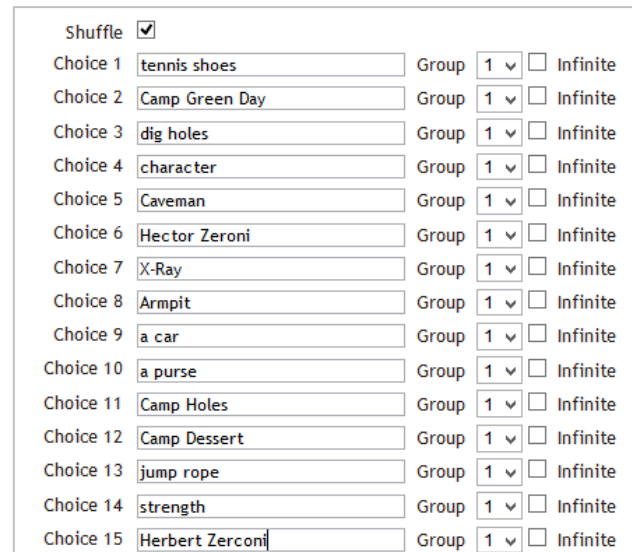
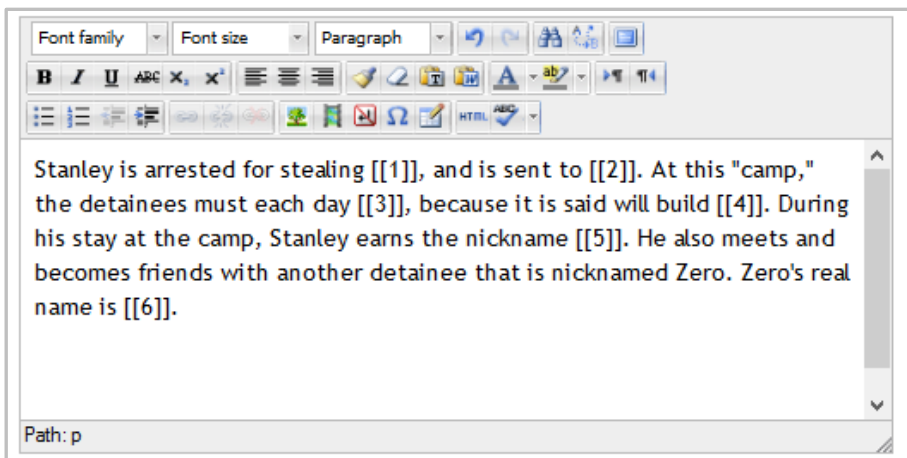


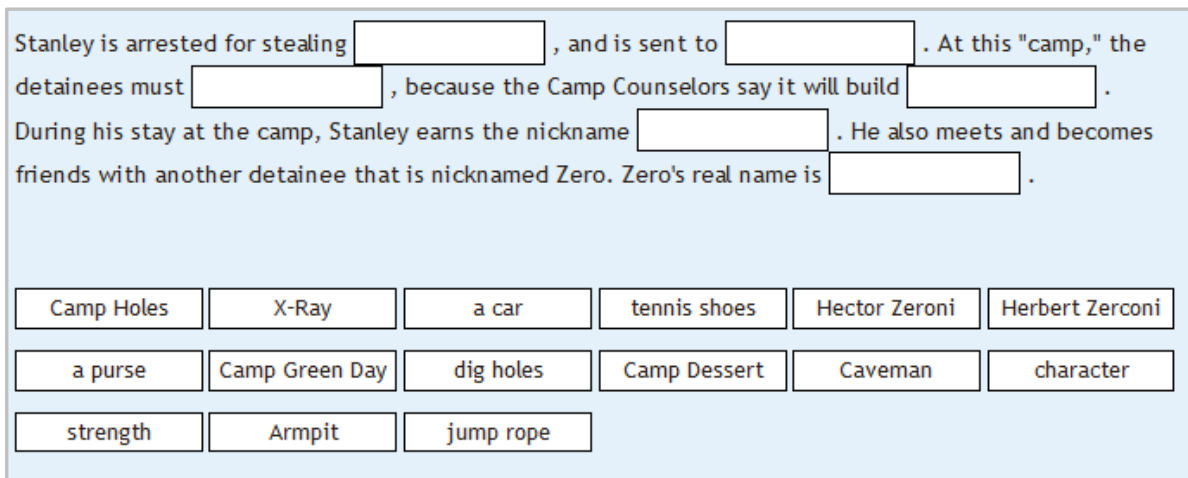
INTERACTIVE MOODLE QUIZ QUESTIONS

Question Type - Drag & Drop into Text

1. From the Settings block, select Question Bank → Questions.
2. Choose the appropriate quiz category, then select **Create a New Question**.
3. Select the **Drag and Drop into Text question**, then click **Next**.
4. For the Question Text window, type the sentences that students will use to fill in the blanks. For each area that will have a blank, enter double brackets with a number inside of it, numbering the items consecutively. For example, the first blank will be written with **[[1]]**, the second blank will be **[[2]]**, and so on. Notice the example in the first image (on the left) below.



5. In the "Choice" section you must enter the correct answers for the corresponding bracketed items in the question text. After the correct answers are listed, you can then add additional blanks for more options. For the second image, above (on the right), notice how choices #1 through #6 match the answers for the bracketed items #1 - #6 in the question text.
6. The actual quiz question will look like the image below. Students will drag the text to the correct blank areas.
