


## CREATING MATCHING QUESTIONS

The steps to create a Matching question in Moodle are as follows:

1. Go to the Question Bank screen (*see the previous page if you don't remember how to do this*).
2. Be sure you are in the correct category, then select **Create a New Question**. Select **Matching** from the pop-up window.

3. When the "Adding a Matching Question" window appears, verify that you are in the correct quiz category, then enter a brief **Question Name** and also the **Question Text**, which will be the question or statement that the students see when taking the quiz. Since this is a matching exercise, briefly explain what the students will be expected to match.



4. For the **Default grade**, be sure to include points for each matched item. For example, if each correct match is worth 1 point and there will be 5 items to match, the default grade should be 5 (not 1).

5. For "Question 1," enter the **Question** and the **Answer** information. In the screen at the right, I entered just a single word, *Apple* (*but questions can also be phrases or sentences*). In the **Answer** box I listed the item that it should be matched with -- *Red*. Continue adding "Question 2," "Question 3," and so on until all matching items are entered.

6. When finished, scroll to the bottom and select **Save Changes**.
